Korea possesses a dynamic and modern economy: a population of over 50 million, a stable and business friendly political environment, excellent transportation links, and Internet connectivity (both in terms of speeds and penetration) consistently ranked as the best in the world. Rapid development since the 1970s (dubbed 'The Miracle on the Han') saw the emergence of world-leading brands such as Samsung, LG and Hyundai. The EU-Republic of Korea Free Trade Agreement will eliminate tariffs on 97% of goods by 2014. This is already leading to increased British exports. Developing further our trade and investment relationship with Korea is a high priority for the UK government.
